Acme United profit increases

Acme United, the Fairfield-based supplier of cutting, measuring and safety products, said earnings rose 7 percent to \$2.20 million, or 68 cents per diluted share, for the quarter ended June 30, compared with \$2.06 million, or 66 cents a share, for the comparable period in 2012. Sales climbed 5 percent due to increased back-to-school sales and the acquisition of the C-Thru Ruler Co. in June last year. Shares of Acme United, traded under the symbol "ACU," jumped 3 percent to \$13.40 in trading Friday.

Bridgeport Hospital among 'Most Wired'

Yale New Haven Health System, including Bridgeport, Greenwich and Yale-New Haven hospitals, has been selected as one of the "Most Wired" health systems in the nation by Hospitals and Health Networks, published by the American Hospital Association. 
